KEY ACHIEVEMENTS OF 2023

Child Protection:

- Partnered with UNICEF to support 40 villages in establishing child care mechanisms.
- Reached 16,000 children through the AMANAT Project, providing clothing and essentials.
- Health Camps:
 - Conducted 20 health camps in rural and underserved areas, benefiting over 5,000 individuals.
 - Collaborated with local healthcare providers to ensure basic medical services and hygiene awareness.
- Celebrations:

Organized World Children's Day, Girl Child Day, and International Women's Day, engaging over 10,000 participants.

Child Protection Programs

- Community-Based Care Mechanisms:
 - Worked in partnership with UNICEF to identify and support children in need across 40 villages.
 - Developed community-led care groups to address child welfare issues.
- AMANAT Project:
 - Distributed uniforms, winter clothing, and educational kits to over 16,000 underprivileged children.
 - Created awareness drives in schools to highlight the importance of inclusivity and support for vulnerable students.
- Advocacy for Child Rights:
 - Produced 50 case studies to document challenges faced by children in Kashmir.
 - Developed promotional materials rooted in Islamic Shariah for culturally relevant awareness campaigns.




Health and Well-Being Initiatives
